Auguste Escoffier (1847-1935) the “*Father of Modern Cuisine*” was a renowned chef, teacher, and author of Le Guide Culinaire and many more books and publications. Born in France in the small village of Villeneuve-Loubet near Nice, his culinary visions were known not only in France but eventually influenced cuisine worldwide. When the Savoy Hotel was opened in London in 1898 under the direction of Escoffier and Cesar Ritz, grand cuisine was still the exception. Together, the two chefs waged a successful campaign to assure that their *a la carte* offerings were the finest and their service the best. Escoffier simplified the classical menu in accordance with the principles of Anton Careme and initiated the kitchen brigade system. It is in this spirit that The World of MBI has created this trip - the 3rd of its kind- to keep alive the memory and lifetime culinary achievements of Auguste Escoffier and to gain a better understanding and appreciation of the art of good living and the traditions of French cuisine.
